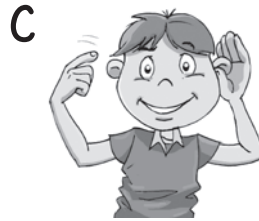
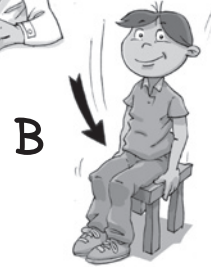

Focus: spelling of school objects

- › Ss should look at the icons and tell you what they have to do.
- › Since Ss are already familiar with those school objects, you can start by eliciting which words they could find in the word puzzle.
- › If they are not familiar with this kind of activity you can work on a strategy: they can use a ruler to find the words, this will make the work easier.
- › Elicit from them where they can check if they do not remember all the words for school objects.
- › Check the answers on the bb.
